Conditions of Entry and Competition

Entry	<p>Eligibility: Entry is open to female players who are financial members of a MPDWG affiliated golf club and hold current Australian Women's Handicaps.</p> <p>Handicap limit: 45</p>	
Format	<p>The Championship qualifying rounds are stroke. The MPDWG Championships will be decided by scratch Matchplay. The players with the eight lowest scratch scores in each grade in the qualifying rounds will qualify.</p> <p>A Grade 0-18: 36 hole stroke event played over two days. Eight players to qualify.</p> <p>B Grade 19-27: 18 holes stroke. Eight players to qualify.</p> <p>C Grade 28-45: 18 holes stroke. Eight players to qualify.</p>	
Entry fee	A Grade \$30 B & C Grade \$20	
Conditions	<p>MPDWG 2010 STANDARD CONDITIONS OF ENTRY APPLY.</p> <p>Entries into District Championships accepted up to midnight of closing date.</p> <p>No substitutes will be allowed.</p> <p>Order of Play: A Grade will be seeded in handicap order according to handicaps at date of entry for both qualifying rounds. B & C Grades to be seeded in handicap order on handicaps at date of entry.</p> <p>Players to use handicap current on first day of play, throughout all rounds of Championships.</p> <p>Players 70 years of age and over are allowed to use a motorised vehicle.</p> <p>If a player has a permanent disability or is recovering from serious injury or illness and is unable to play without the use of a motorised vehicle or bike, the player must carry a current medical certificate. Host clubs may not permit the use of carts due to local conditions. It is the player's responsibility to organize golf cart hire/usage at the relevant club.</p> <p>Draw will be available at www.mpdwg.asn.au within 10 days of entries closing.</p>	
Ties	<p>In the qualifying rounds in the event of a tie there will be a count back.</p> <p>Ties in the matchplay will continue sudden death hole by hole until a winner is decided.</p>	
Matchplay	<p>Qualifying positions for the matchplay event will be decided by GA automatic draw.</p> <p>Players unavailable to play in the matchplay event are automatically disqualified after play in the qualifying round. The next best qualifier will replace the unavailable player.</p> <p>Players receiving an official walkover need not be present on the day of play</p>
