

2011 MPDWG Hiscock Salver Conditions of Entry and Competition

1. History

The Hiscock Salver was donated by Misses D and M Hiscock in 1968 originally being for the pennant playoff between the North and South A Grade Pennant Zones. When the Northern Zone did not field an A Grade team the Salver was played for by the A Grade first and second teams on the pennant ladder. In 1972, the Hiscock Salver became an annual team's event for players who had played pennant in that year. In 2010, the conditions were changed to allow pennant, handicap match play and caddies to play in the club's team.

2. Competition

- a. The 2011, Hiscock Salver is an 18 Holes Stableford teams event consisting of four players who have played pennant or handicap match play or caddied in 2011.
- b. The team recording the highest number of stableford points will be the winners.
- c. There will be an individual stableford event in two grades. Grades to be determined on the day of play.

3. Eligibility

Open to any female amateur player holding an official Golf Australia handicap at an MPDWG affiliated club who have either played pennant, handicap match play or caddied in 2011.

4. Entries

- a. The entry fee is \$30.00 per team
- b. In the case of withdrawal, clubs are requested to contact the MPDWG Tournament Secretary.
- c. The draw for the Hiscock Salver will be available at www.mpdwg.asn.au within 10 days of entries closing.

5. Conditions of Competition

- a. 2011 Standard Conditions of Entry for all MPDWG events apply.
- b. Players and caddies are required to comply with the dress standards of the host club.
- c. **Ties** – There will be a count-back according to the Golf Australia method.
- d. Players may use motorised golf carts.
