## PORTSEA GOLF CLUB LADIES' OPEN DAY 4BBB STABLEFORD

### CONDITIONS OF ENTRY AND COMPETITION

#### 1. Competition

- a. The Open Day event will be played over 18 holes 4 Ball Better Ball Stableford.
- b. The winners will be the players with the best 4 Ball Better Ball Stableford Score.

#### 2. Eligibility

- a. Open to female amateur players holding an official Golf Australia Handicap

#### 3. Entries

- a. The entry fee is \$35.00 per pair.
- b. In the instance the number of entries exceeds the maximum field capacity, **a ballot by entry will occur.** Unsuccessful entries will be informed without delay and given the opportunity to compete if withdrawals occur. Money received from balloted entrants who do not subsequently compete, will be refunded in full.
- c. The draw for the Open Day will be available at [www.portseagolf.com.au](http://www.portseagolf.com.au) within 8 days of entries closing.

#### 4. Conditions of Competition

- a. Competition shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Club of St. Andrews, Scotland, subject to such local rules as are in force at the Portsea Golf Club
- b. The Match Committee to make all arrangements and have full power to alter or make any variation in the conditions of play should they deem it desirable and shall have the right to refuse the entry of any person without being required to give any reason for such refusal.
- c. Any dispute or protest will be decided by the Match Committee whose decision is final.
- d. Players not ready to start at the appointed time may be relegated to the end of the field.
- e. In the event of a tie a count-back according to the Golf Australia method will be used.
- f. Substitutes are permitted.
- g. Players are permitted to use motorised golf carts. The hire of golf carts is at the players own expense subject to arrangements and agreements with Portsea Golf Club.
- h. A player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only. If, during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance-measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (eg windspeed, gradient, temperature etc), the player is in breach of rule 14-3, for which the penalty is disqualification, regardless of whether any such additional function is actually used.

**Note. The use of a distance measuring device that has a compass as one of its features, such as a 'Smart Phone', is specifically precluded.**

#### 6. Registration

Players are asked to arrive at Portsea Golf Course at least 30 minutes prior to the stipulated tee time.

#### 7. Database of Competitors' Details

The personal data contained in this entry maybe retained by Portsea Golf Club and utilised for the distribution of correspondence, in both electronic and hard copy means. From time to time players may be sent entry forms and event literature about events conducted by Portsea Golf Club. Upon receipt by Portsea Golf Club of a written request, a player may either have access to their details, or have their details deleted from the database.
