CONDITIONS OF PLAY

CHAMPIONSHIP COMMITTEE

The committee shall consist of the Match Committees and Managers of the Portsea and Sorrento Golf Clubs, or such members thereof as may be available.

The Committee shall have the sole management and control of the tournament and full power at any time, to alter or vary any of the conditions. The decision of the Committee shall be final.

ENTRIES

Entries will be restricted to amateurs who are members of Golf Clubs registered with such State or Overseas Associations as are affiliated with or recognized by Golf Australia and who hold a current handicap not exceeding eighteen (18) strokes as at date of entry. The Committee shall have the right to refuse the entry of any person without being required to give any reason for such refusal

"Amateur" means an amateur in accordance with the Rules of Amateur Status as approved by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews, Scotland.

Entry fees must be paid at the time of entry. Refunds will NOT be made for scratchings notified after the closing date for the receipt of entries.

Entries close Friday 20th January 2012. The Championship Committee shall have the power to limit the number of entries. Players must be prepared to move up the time sheet if requested by the starter.

RULES

The events shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews, together with such local rules as are in force on the course during the tournament. If a dispute arises it shall be decided by the Committee whose decision shall be final.

The following local rule will apply during the tournament: "If a player arrives at his starting point ready to play within 5 minutes after his starting time, in the absence of circumstances which warrant waiving the penalty of disqualification, as provided in Rule 33-7, the penalty for failure to start on time is two strokes. Penalty for lateness beyond five minutes maybe disqualification."

SCORECARDS

Completed and signed cards must be returned within 15 minutes of finishing the round. Failure to hand in a card within the appointed time will result in a "No Card Returned" entry.

PROTESTS

Protests must be lodged in writing with the Championship Referee not later than 10 minutes after conclusion of the day play.

DRAW

A draw for each day's play will be made by the Match Committee, which has the power to amend the draw or substitute another player for one who is not on the tee at the appointment time. It may also alter the starting time for any player. Competitors must be ready on the tee at least **Ten** minutes before the appointed start time.

TIES

In the event of a tie for the Point Nepean Trophy, the A.S. Patterson Cup or The Cheviot Cup, there will be a sudden death play off commencing on the 1st hole immediately at the conclusion of regular play. All other ties shall be decided by count back as per GA regulations.

HANDICAPS

The Committee has the power to temporarily alter a player's handicap. If a player alters her handicap during the course of the 36-hole event, the original handicap shall prevail. For the A.S. Patterson Cup the reduced handicap will apply. It is each player's responsibility to ascertain her correct handicap.

GOLF CARTS

Only those persons authorized to use a motorised cart may do so. Authorisation must be sought from a member of the Match Committee and would usually be supported by written medical certification.

In the event of bad weather, or for any other reason, the Match Committee may either shorten the Tournament or appoint another day for play.
