

MPDWG Entry and Refund Conditions

1. Entries must be made using the MPDWG entry forms, within the specified opening and closing dates of entry.
2. The decision of the Mornington Peninsula District Women's Golf Match Committee as to the acceptance or refusal of any entry will be final.
3. In the event of entry applications exceeding the number of places available in any event, entries will be decided by the ballot system as described in each individual event conditions of entry and play. Unsuccessful entrants will be informed without delay and be placed on a waiting list, in order of ballot and will be given a position in the field if withdrawals occur. Monies received from balloted entrants, who do not compete, will be refunded in full.
4. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Mornington Peninsula District Women's Golf Match Committee. Any such entry will be subject to a late entry fee of \$10, in addition to the Entrance Fee indicated on the relevant event entry form.
5. Acceptable payment methods are cheque (personal or bank), money order or cash. Mornington Peninsula District Women's Golf takes no responsibility for cash that accompanies hard copy entries and is not received. Cheques or money orders are to be made payable to MPDWG Inc.
6. Entry fees will only be refunded in the case of a withdrawal being advised to Mornington Peninsula District Women's Golf Tournament Secretary prior to the closing date for entries unless an exceptional circumstance, as approved by the Mornington Peninsula District Women's Golf Match Committee warrants a refund.
