

2011 MPDWG Sorrento Plate Conditions of Entry and Competition.

1. History

In 1989, Ronnie Ferguson initiated the Sorrento Plate as a fund raiser for junior girls' golf on the Mornington Peninsula. The event is to be held annually at Sorrento Golf Club in July school holidays. The inaugural event was won by Louise McDonald, a junior at Portsea Golf Club and Marjorie Kellaway also from Portsea.

2. Competition

- a. The Sorrento Plate will be played over 18 holes 4 Ball Better Ball Stableford.
- b. The winners will be the players with the best 4 Ball Better Ball Stableford Score.

3. Eligibility

- a. Open to any female amateur player holding an official Golf Australia handicap at an MPDWG affiliated club.

4. Entries

- a. The entry fee is \$30.00
- b. Entries will be accepted and refunded in accordance with MPDWG Refund and Entry Conditions
- c. In the instance the number of entries exceeds the maximum field capacity, **a ballot by entry will occur**. Unsuccessful entries will be informed without delay and given the opportunity to compete if withdrawals occur. Money received from balloted entrants who do not subsequently compete, will be refunded in full.
- d. The draw for the Sorrento Plate will be available at www.mpdwg.asn.au within 10 days of entries closing.

5. Conditions of Competition

- a. 2011 Standard Conditions of Entry for all MPDWG events apply.
- b. Players and caddies are required to comply with the dress standards of the host club.
- c. **Ties** – There will be a count-back according to the Golf Australia method.
- d. **Substitutes** – One eligible substitute accepted per pair.
- e. Players may use motorised golf carts.

6. Trophies

Trophies will be awarded to:
Winners
Runners Up
Nearest the Pins
Longest Drive A, B, C grades and Junior.

7. Registration

- a. Players are asked to arrive at Sorrento Golf Course at least 30 minutes prior to the stipulated tee time. **Shotgun start at 8.30am.**

8. Administration

MPDWG are responsible for engraving the trophy.
